Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 Panel (10130-1)
- 1 Yard - Orange Halloween Motif (10132-4)
- 1/2 Yard - Black Patches (10133-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Orange/Black Diamonds (10134-4)
- 1/4 Yard - Green/Black Diamonds (10134-5)
- 3/4 Yard - Orange/Black Stripe (10135-1)
- 1/8 Yard - Brown/White Stripe (10135-3)
- 1/2 Yard - Black/Orange Leaves (10136-1)
- 3/4 Yard - Black Web (10137-1)
- 1/4 Yard - Orange Web (10137-4)
- 1/2 Yard - Binding Black Patches
- 4 Yards - Backing of your choice
Suggested: Black Halloween Motif (10131-1)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

From the Orange Halloween Motif:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips
- 3 - 4 1/2" x WOF strips pieced into:
2 - 4 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips
- 4 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

From Black Patches cut:

- 5 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips pieced into:
2 - 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips
2 - 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips

From the Orange/Black Diamonds cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips
- 4 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Green/Black Diamond cut:

- 4 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares
- 8 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

From the Orange/Black Stripe cut:

- 9 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips cut into:
2 - 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangles
2 - 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" rectangles
2 - 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" rectangles
2 - 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangles
8 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Brown/White Stripe cut:

- 4 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

From the Black/Orange Leaves cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips
- 4 Moon Shapes

From the Black Web cut:

- 8 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips
- 8 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- 16 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

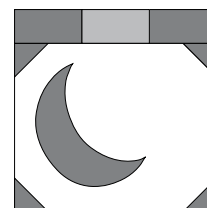
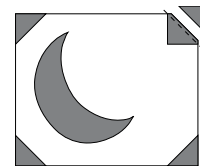
From the Orange Web cut:

- 4 - 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Directions

1. Cut the panel to measure 21 1/2" x 23 1/2". Sew a 2 1/2" x WOF Black Web strip to the left and right edges of the panel. Trim the excess fabric from the strip where it extends past the top and bottom of the panel. Press the seams away from the panel. Sew a 2 1/2" x WOF Black Web strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel. Trim the excess fabric from the strip where it extends past the left and right edges of the panel. Press the seams away from the panel. Trim the panel section and borders to measure 22 1/2" x 24 1/2".
2. With right sides together, sew a 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" Orange/Black Stripe to each side of the panel and press. Sew a 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Green/Black Diamond square to each end of two 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Orange/Black Stripe strips and press. Sew each of these strips to the top and bottom of the center panel and press.
3. Sew a 2 1/2" Orange Halloween motif, Black Web and Orange/Black Diamond strips together to form a strip set. Press seams toward away from the center strip. Repeat to make a total of two strip sets. Cut these strip sets into twenty-four 2 1/2" segments.
4. Make second strip set by sewing a 2 1/2" Black Web, Orange Halloween Motif and Black/Orange Leaves strips together. Press seams toward the center strip. Repeat to make a total of two strip sets. Cut these strip sets into twenty-two 2 1/2" segments.
5. Sew the strip set segments together alternating and flipping them as shown in the picture. Sew together twelve sections for each side and eleven sections for the top and bottom.
6. Appliqué the moon shapes to the 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" Orange Web rectangles using the method of your choice. *Note: If you wish to turn under the edges please add 1/4" to the template provided.*
7. Place a 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Black Web square on each corner of the Orange Web rectangles. Draw and sew a diagonal line. Trim corner to 1/4" and press outward as shown. Make a total of four units.
8. Sew an 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Black Web rectangle to each side of an 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" White/Brown rectangle and press. Repeat to make a total of four units. Sew these units to the top of the pumpkin blocks as shown.
9. Sew a 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Orange/Black Stripe to the ends of the units created in step 5. Sew the longer of these units to each side of the quilt top and press. Add a pumpkin unit from step 6 to each end of the remaining two units. Sew these to the top and bottom and press.
10. With right sides together, sew the 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Orange/Black Stripe to each side of the center panel and press. Sew a 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Green/Black Diamond square to each end of the 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" Orange/Black Stripes and press. Sew each of these strips to the top and bottom of the center panel and press.
11. Repeat step 10 using the Orange Halloween Motif strips and the remaining Green/Black Diamond squares.
12. Repeat step 10 using the black patches strips and the orange black diamond squares.



Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and the backing. Baste the layers together.
2. Hand or machine quilt as desired. Square up the quilt sandwich.
3. Prepare the binding for the quilt by stitching the 2 1/2" Black Patches strips end to end. Press the binding in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Sew the binding to the quilt. Add a hanging sleeve, if desired, and a label.
